Speech by Plácido DOMINGO, President of Europa Nostra

President Barroso, Commissioner Vassiliou, Distinguished guests, Dear friends,

What an **honour** for me to stand here at the very **heart** of the European decision-making. And what a **joy** to open, together with Commissioner Vassiliou, this **exhibition which celebrates a very fruitful partnership** between the European Commission and Europa Nostra through the **European Union Prize for Cultural Heritage/ Europa Nostra Awards**. And what a **pride** for me - and the entire Europa Nostra family - to close in such a **prestigious** way the **50**<sup>th</sup> **Anniversary Year** of our organisation.

**President Barroso**, your presence honours us and confirms your **firm belief** that our culture is our strength. And that **culture** ought to take a **much more prominent place** within the **"New Narrative for Europe"**. We **support** this initiative and have been **actively involved** in the "New Narrative for Europe" initiative. In the future, Europa Nostra shall gladly continue to be both **one of the architects** and **one of the ambassadors** of this initiative. We agree with you that this New Narrative must be communicated to the widest possible audience across Europe.

Let me add that we **feel encouraged** by the **inclusion** of cultural heritage concerns in **other important programmes** of the European Union, in particular the **future structural funds** and also the programme for **research and innovation "Horizon 2020"**. As you know, Europa Nostra very **strongly supports the current momentum** for developing a **more ambitious EU strategy for cultural heritage** which is **fully integrated** in **all** relevant EU policies.

**Cultural Heritage Counts for Europe!** This is the title of an **ambitious project** on which Europa Nostra together with **other partners** from the **European Heritage Alliance 3.3.** - is currently working, with the much appreciated support of the European Commission.

Cultural heritage is indeed a key resource for the future of Europe. For Europe's economy and especially tourism...for the sustainable development of Europe's cities and countryside...., for the education of new generations of Europeans..., for the protection of our environment..., for Europe's public diplomacy and also for Europe's cultural diplomacy. And let us not forget that some of those sites are today **in danger**, as shown by our new programme "**The 7 Most Endangered**", launched in partnership with the **European Investment Bank Institute.** 

Please allow me to make a toast to a wonderful decade of fruitful partnership between Europa Nostra and the European Commission with the organisation of our Awards and to express a hope that this partnership will continue to grow in strength and impact also in the future!
